





Agreement of Academic Collaboration Program

For producing and developing human resources of vocational education in business administration Between

Bangkok College of Business Administration and Tourism and YCH (Thailand) Co., Ltd.

This Agreement of Collaboration Program is made between Bangkok College of Business Administration and Tourism by Dr. Chairit Saengsawang, Director of Bangkok College of Business Administration and Tourism, located at 11 Soi Leabklongsong 19, Leabklongsong Rd., Klongsamwa, Bangkok 10510, hereinafter referred as the Academic Institute as one party and YCH (Thailand) Co.,Ltd. by Mr. Terence Ang located at 128 Soi Chalongkrung 31, Lamplathiew, Ladkrabang, Bangkok 10520 hereinafter referred in this agreement as the Operational Place as the other party.

Bangkok College of Business Administration and Tourism which is the government agency in the control of the Office of the Vocational Education Commission and YCH (Thailand) Co.,Ltd., have the mutual intention in managing the vocational education and professional training for producing the staffs in the levels of craftsmen, technicians, and technology staffs. The emphasis is put on enabling the learners to gain knowledge, skills, and real experience from the Operational Place.

Both parties have agreed to make the Agreement of Collaborative Program in academic affairs by arranging the curriculum, developing the curriculum, and developing the academic competence in the level of high vocational certificate, program in General Management and Logistic Management. The students will be allowed to take the internship in the Operational Place as well as being stimulated to improve their knowledge from studying the real experience with the details as follows:

Clause 1 Objectives

- 1.1 To cooperate between public and private sectors in arranging the vocational education in the management and logistics.
- 1.2 To produce the students with the knowledge and expertise in the management and logistics who can manage and control the operation, integrate the knowledge, skills, and experiences apart from in the textbooks or classrooms in order to be applied in solving problems and developing the operation in the technological changing
- 1.3 To build the readiness for the students in gaining knowledge and improve their competence to respond to the demand of the Operational Place.
